Edibles are health hazards for infants, young children and pets.



In Colorado, marijuana exposures increased 169% for children ages 0-5 after legalization.

Colorado has more marijuana businesses than McDonald's and Starbucks combined.

- Cap THC levels to no more than 10%.
- Provide strong marijuana education for medical marijuana cardholders, youth, pregnant women and the public.
